GUIDELINES FOR THE PROPOSAL DEFENCE IN FACULTY OF ENGINEERING

(For Engineering Postgraduate Programme)

PROCEDURE

- (1) The candidate **MUST** have completed Research Methodology course.
- (2) Candidates are required to submit the Proposal Defence Report (**between 3,000 – 7,000 words**) at the end of Week 11 of the semester through a Microsoft form submission link <https://forms.office.com/r/ebTrxq4fGx>. The report and slides presentation must contain the following aspects:
 - a. Abstract (500 words in Bahasa Malaysia and English;
 - b. Introduction, Statement of Problem, Scope of Research;
 - c. Research Objective;
 - d. Summary of the literature review;
 - e. Description Conceptual Framework/Summary of Methods/Summary of Research;
 - f. Importance and relevance of the study;
 - g. preliminary findings / pilot test (if any);
 - h. Work Schedule in the form of Gantt Chart; and
 - i. Concise bibliography
- (3) Checklist for the Submission of Research Proposal:

<input type="checkbox"/>	Page Number
<input type="checkbox"/>	In between 8-12 pages (excluding cover page)
- (4) The research proposal will be distributed to the panel one week before the presentation.
- (5) The time given for presentation is **15 minutes** following with question and answer session for **at least 15 minutes**.
- (6) Postgraduate Office will update the Proposal Defence result in the Maya Portal and candidates may check the results before the semester ends.
- (7) **The Cover Page of Proposal Defence Report must be verified and signed by the Supervisor(s).**
