

RE-ENTRY VISA (FOR EXISTING INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS)

Only students with **valid** student pass and students with pass that has **expired** during Movement Control Order (MCO) from 1st February 2020 onwards who are currently residing outside the country will be allowed to enter Malaysia.

The existing international students who are currently residing outside Malaysia and wish to return to campus will have to follow the instruction below prior to making their journey to Malaysia:

- 1) Obtain a **Travel Authorization** from the Director General of the Malaysian Immigration Department by applying through the Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS) <https://visa.educationmalaysia.gov.my/guidelines/travel-authorisation-form-base.html>
- 2) Upon receiving the Travel Authorization, download and complete the **Letter of Undertaking (LoU) and Indemnity for Person Under Surveillance**.
- 3) Email **Letter of Undertaking (LoU) and Indemnity for Person Under Surveillance** to the respective **Malaysian Mission** in the home country together with the Travel Authorization (from EMGS), travel documents (flight tickets) and Identity document (copy of Passport) at least three (3) days before the date of departure.

The students can only start their journey to Malaysia once received a **Letter of Approval (Entry Permit) to Malaysia** from the Malaysian Mission via email.

All incoming exiting international students are required to adhere to the latest requirements imposed by the Malaysian Government and the National Disaster Management Agency (NADMA)¹ which include:

- (i) Choose KLIA1 or KLIA2 as the point of entry to Malaysia and follow all instructions at airport upon arrival
- (ii) Undergo a mandatory 14-day quarantine period at designated quarantine areas/hotels identified by NADMA. Students will be fully responsible for **COSTS** related to the quarantine and the specified COVID-19 swab tests.

Estimated Costs:

Designated Quarantine Centres : ≈ RM150 per day
COVID-19 swab tests : ≈ RM310

(iii) Download MySejahtera application on smartphone when entering Malaysia

Notes:

- ✓ Students are required to check with the respective airlines if there are any specific requirements to undergo any Covid-19 screenings before boarding the aircraft.
- ✓ Students who display Covid-19 symptoms will be referred to the hospital immediately for further treatment as per the guidelines set by the Ministry of Health, Malaysia.
